



RENAISSANCE FABRICS

Sunbrella® Renaissance furniture fabrics use post-industrial recycled Sunbrella fiber with virgin Sunbrella fiber to achieve vintage charm, rich coloration, soft feel and excellent performance.

Heritage is the first furniture fabric in the growing collection of Sunbrella Renaissance fabrics. Made of a 50/50 blend of post-industrial recycled and virgin Sunbrella fibers, Heritage offers a homespun look with a natural diversity in the yarn that can feature slubs of contrasting color within the body of the fabric.

The recycled and virgin fibers are blended to help ensure that the product meets stringent Sunbrella performance standards. Recycled Sunbrella content is collected from cutting table waste from various customers, as well as fiber, yarn and fabric waste from the Sunbrella manufacturing facility. This waste is then segmented into color groups, reduced back to its fiber state and finally mixed with Sunbrella virgin fiber before making its way through the manufacturing process.

Due to the recycled nature of this fabric, the shade may vary from lot to lot and large slub yarns may run sporadically throughout the fabric. These slubs are not to be interpreted as imperfections, but as part of the character of the recycled fabric.

Samples of Renaissance fabrics are labeled to inform end users of these slubs and potentially shade variation.
